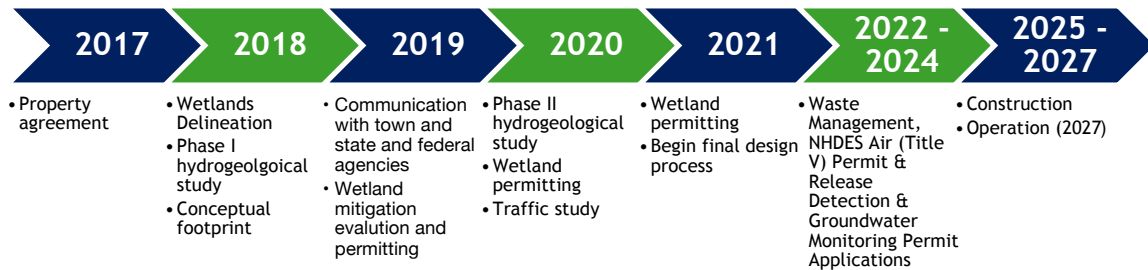


Know the Facts Before you Vote on July 30th

Emergency zoning does not prohibit a landfill

If the town approves emergency zoning it will expire long before NCES even knows whether it is possible to build a landfill in Dalton. The state has a separate, lengthy and thorough process for permitting landfills. The exploratory and permitting process will take years:

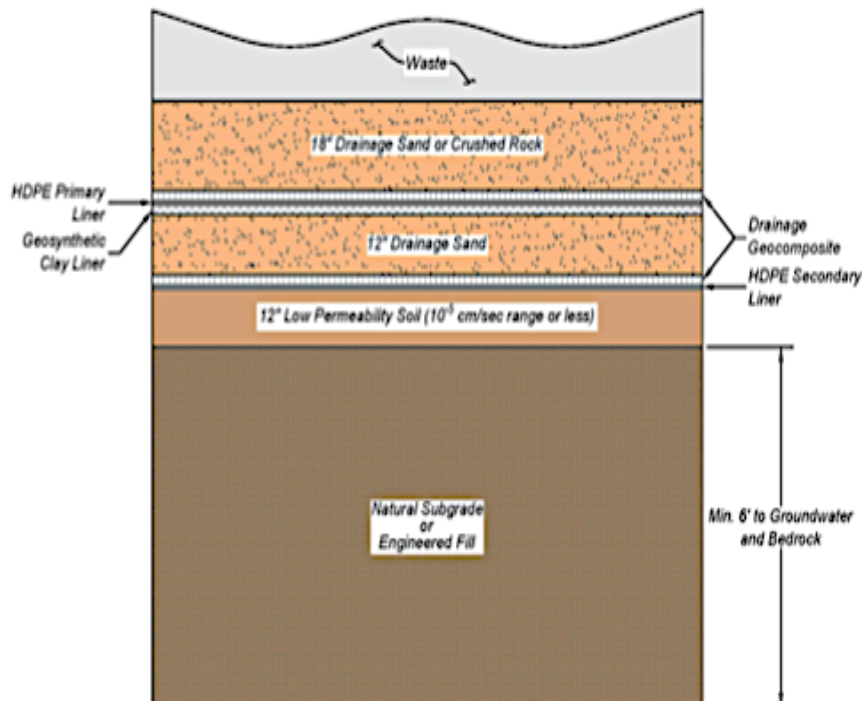
Expected Process Timeline



Will a landfill contaminate our groundwater?

Casella's landfills are highly regulated and highly engineered to ensure that groundwater is not contaminated.

Federal and state regulations are constantly monitoring for contamination and require multiple barriers of protection.



Will a landfill impact Forest Lake?

That is scientifically not possible. Even if liquid could escape from the secure landfill and reach groundwater, it would have to flow uphill and over a ridge to get to Forest Lake. The lake is protected by the laws of physics.

The state also has a robust process to prevent leakage and mitigate odors, traffic and wildlife.
